The State of Military Service in The Seventh-day Adventist Church Conference

FA 45 05 Functions—The World/National Service Organization (WSO/NSO) is an integral element of Adventist Chaplaincy Ministries (ACM) and is the official military relations office of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. Its primary mission is to provide pastoral care and religious resources to support the spiritual well-being of Seventh-day Adventists serving their nations in all aspects of government service, in and out of uniform, including military forces and law enforcement agencies around the world. The organization works in cooperation with the Public Affairs and Religious Liberty department.

1. All divisions form a taskforce comprised of the ACM/PARL departments to become familiar with the 1954 General Conference Session action entitled, “The Relationship of Seventh-day Adventists to Civil Government” and affirmed at the *Autumn Council of the General Conference Committee: General Actions*, October 14-29, 1972, Mexico City. The taskforce should be chaired by a division officer.
2. Prepare a report to be presented at the conference on the state of Military and Police Services, to include information on conscription and alternative to military services in the countries served by the division
