1. Viewing it as part of mission and as part of nurture and retention
2. Administrators writing at least one article
3. Encourage many people to participate, because many authors have never published, but they are now writing for the project
4. Show keen interest as moving around and monitoring progress

5. Giving “air-time” in EXCOMs, Presidents Councils, Secretariat Councils, Treasurers Councils & track progress at Officers Interviews
6. Promotion to generate interest and anticipation in what is coming (people must be eager to go online and read once it is launched)
7. To create a conducive environment for research, like minutes, publications, letters from archives
8. Assist in identifying potential authors
