# Summary of Current Use of Budgets

✓The average score worldwide is 8.1 out of 31 possible points, which highlights the Church's mission drift and the need to refocus mission resources.



# **Mission Refocus Criteria**

- 1. Direct-contact mission with the goal of creating new worshipping groups
- 2. 10/40 Window countries and people groups of non-Christian religions
- 3. Urban areas with populations in excess of 1 million people
- 4. Postmodern/post-Christian countries/regions
- 5. Low Adventist-to-population ratio in countries/regions/people groups
- 6. High impact equipping for directcontact mission
