## Training Members in Personal Evangelism

- ✓ Praying for interests
- ✓ Befriending and ministering to needs
- ✓ Visiting and contacting interests
- ✓ Sharing literature and media
- ✓ Inviting to SS, church, and church events
- ✓ Inviting to take Bible studies
- ✓ Giving Bible studies
- ✓ Mentoring and training new members

INTERESTS.



## Involving Members in Personal Evangelism

- Develop and maintain an active Interest List
- Always be generating more interests
- Elect an Interest Coordinator (*Church Manual*, p. 86)
- Develop a follow-up strategy for each interest
- Assign members to follow up with the interests

#### 2 Keys to the Global Disciple-Making Evangelism Strategy

- It follows the full DISCIPLE-MAKING PROCESS
- 2. It involves every member in PERSONAL MINISTRY





 Gets church members involved in every phase of making disciples.



2. Prioritizes personal ministry—praying, distributing literature/media, inviting, visiting/calling, giving Bible studies, mentoring, etc.



3. Incorporates personal labor into public events for optimum results.



4. Combines health and gospel work like Jesus did.



5. Ensures that interests are being generated prior to reaping events.



6. Leads need-based ministries to generate Bible studies and baptisms.



7. Ensures proper preparation for baptism.



8. Nurtures new members and trains them to win souls.



9. Multiplies workers instead of merely adding members.



10. Develops a culture in which every church is a training school.
