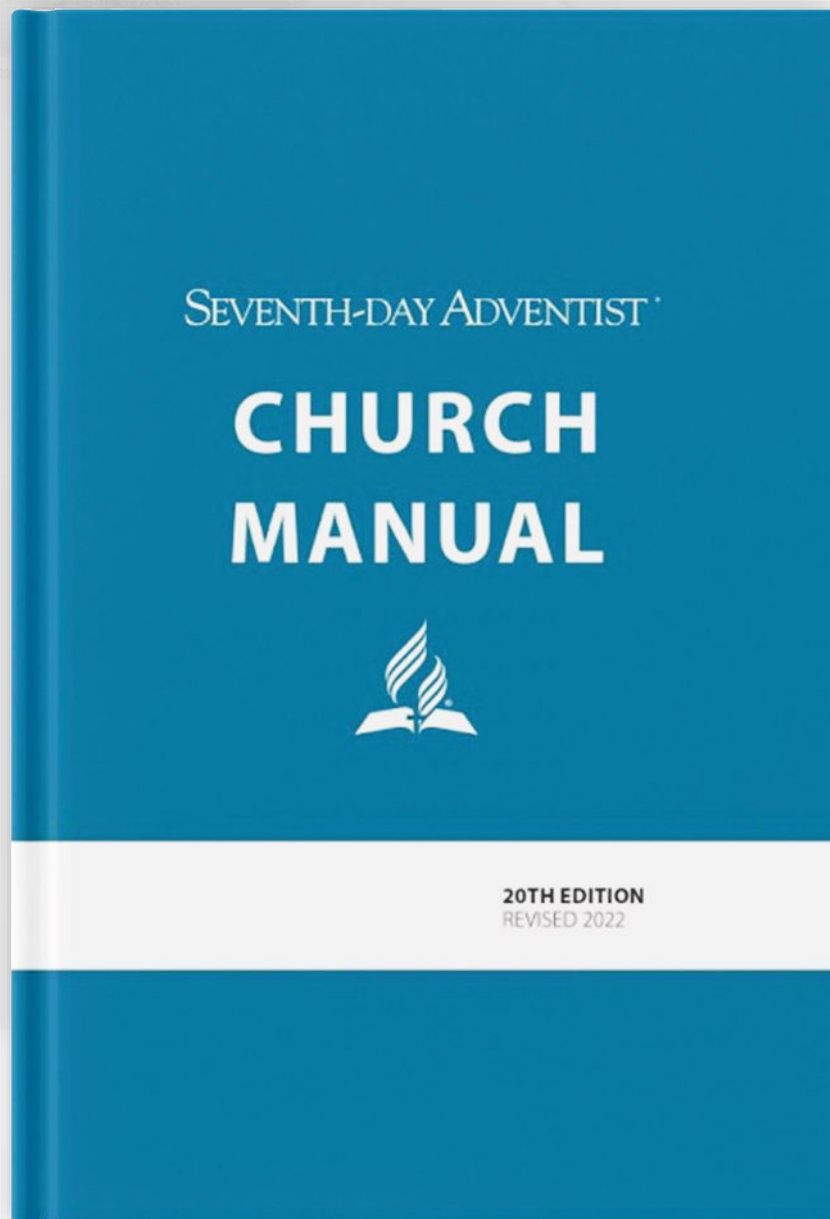

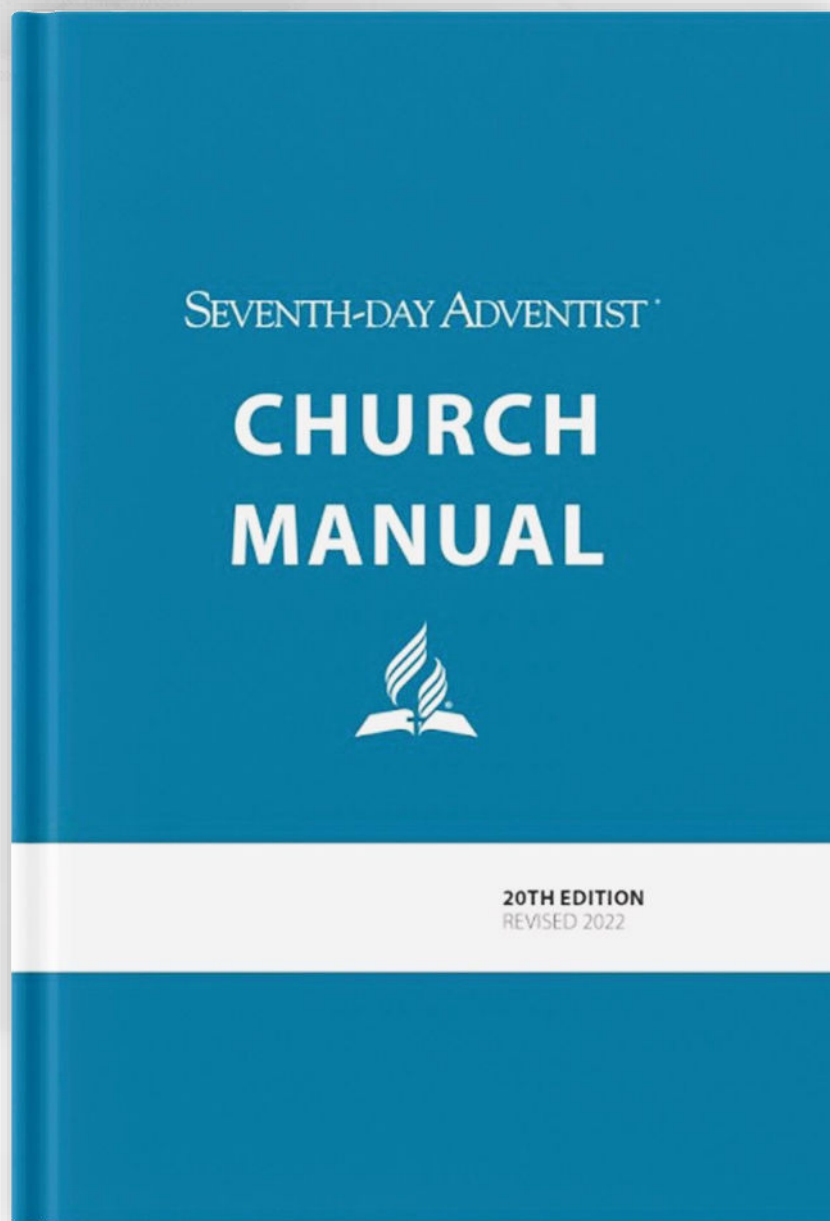

Total Member Involvement (TMI) is a global initiative, but its success depends on the faithful efforts of **pastors and lay leaders in local churches.**

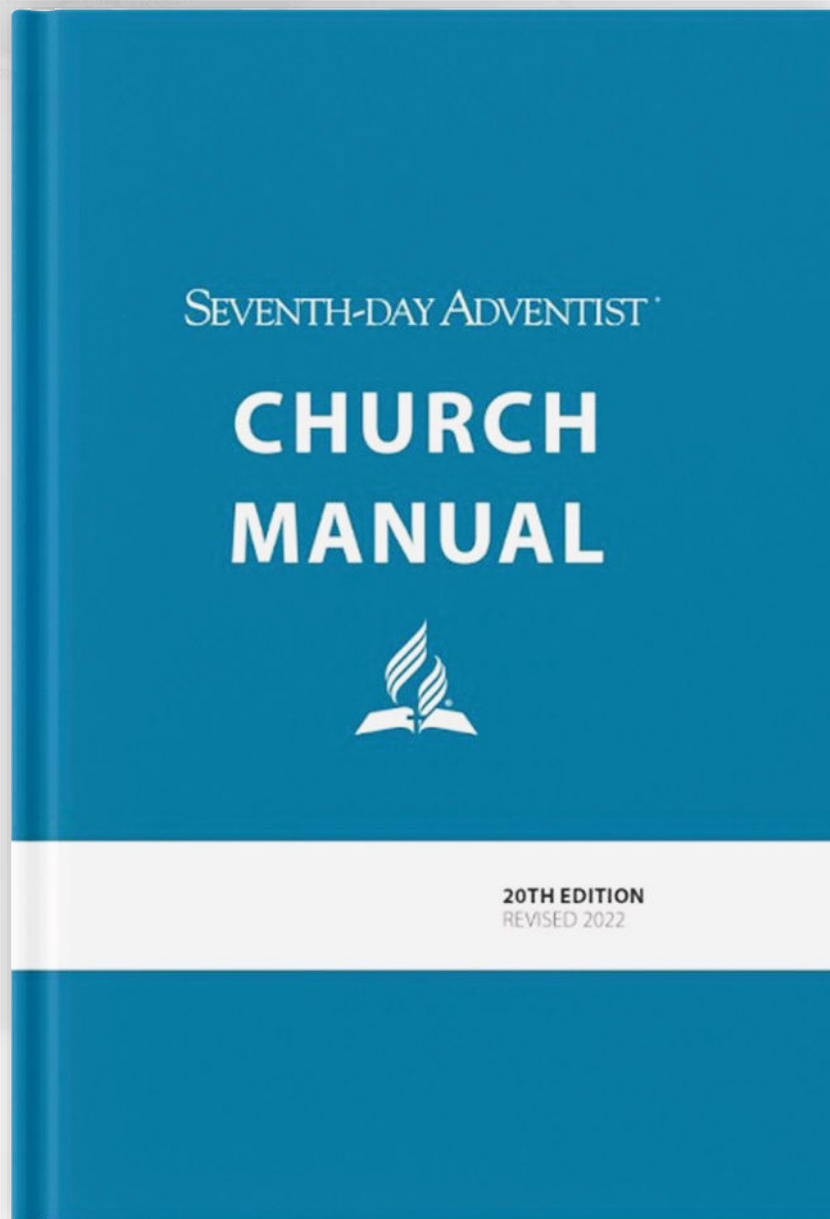




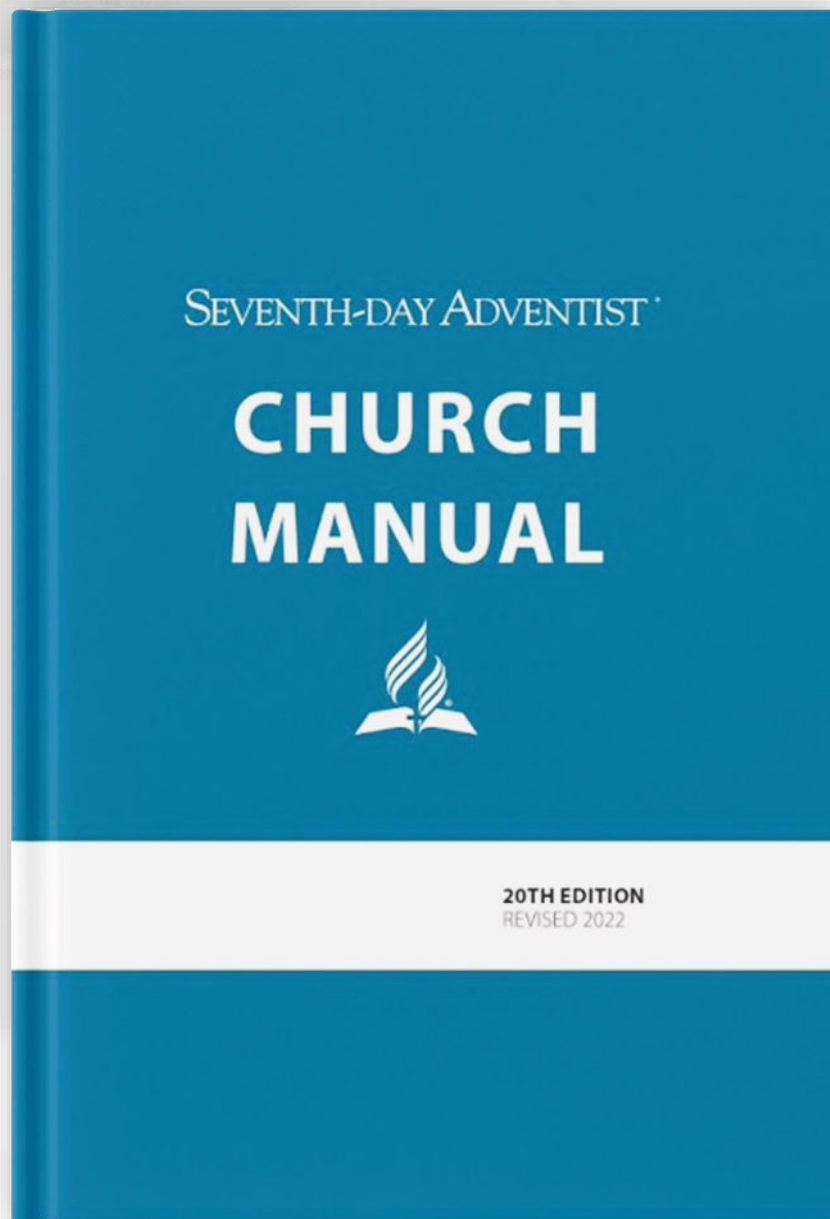

In harmony with the *Church Manual*, Global TMI provides **a single framework** for the local church's discipleship plan that includes both outreach ministries and spiritual nurture.

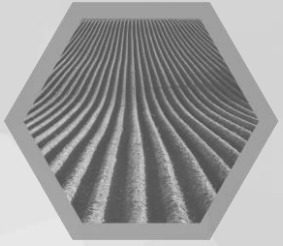

Steps for an Effective YouTube Evangelism Ministry

1. On our HopeLives 365 channel we produce programs of 5, 20, and 45 minutes to attract the largest number of viewers. To build a YouTube audience you need consistency in programming.



Steps for an Effective YouTube Evangelism Ministry

2. We stream our Bible Studies/evangelistic meetings from Restream to multiple platforms since it is more stable than zoom.



Steps for an Effective YouTube Evangelism Ministry

3. Advertising brochures and social media advertising encourages members to invite friends to their churches, homes, and offices.



Steps for an Effective YouTube Evangelism Ministry

4. All graphics are produced in the local language of our target audience.



Steps for an Effective YouTube Evangelism Ministry

5. For evangelistic meetings we recommend using a single language for people of that language group in one county.



Steps for an Effective YouTube Evangelism Ministry

6. Appeals done correctly and response devices work well on YouTube.



Steps for an Effective YouTube Evangelism Ministry

7. Make offers by having people request free PDF downloads of the sermons. Enlist a team of volunteers to respond to phone calls, comments, requests, and decisions.

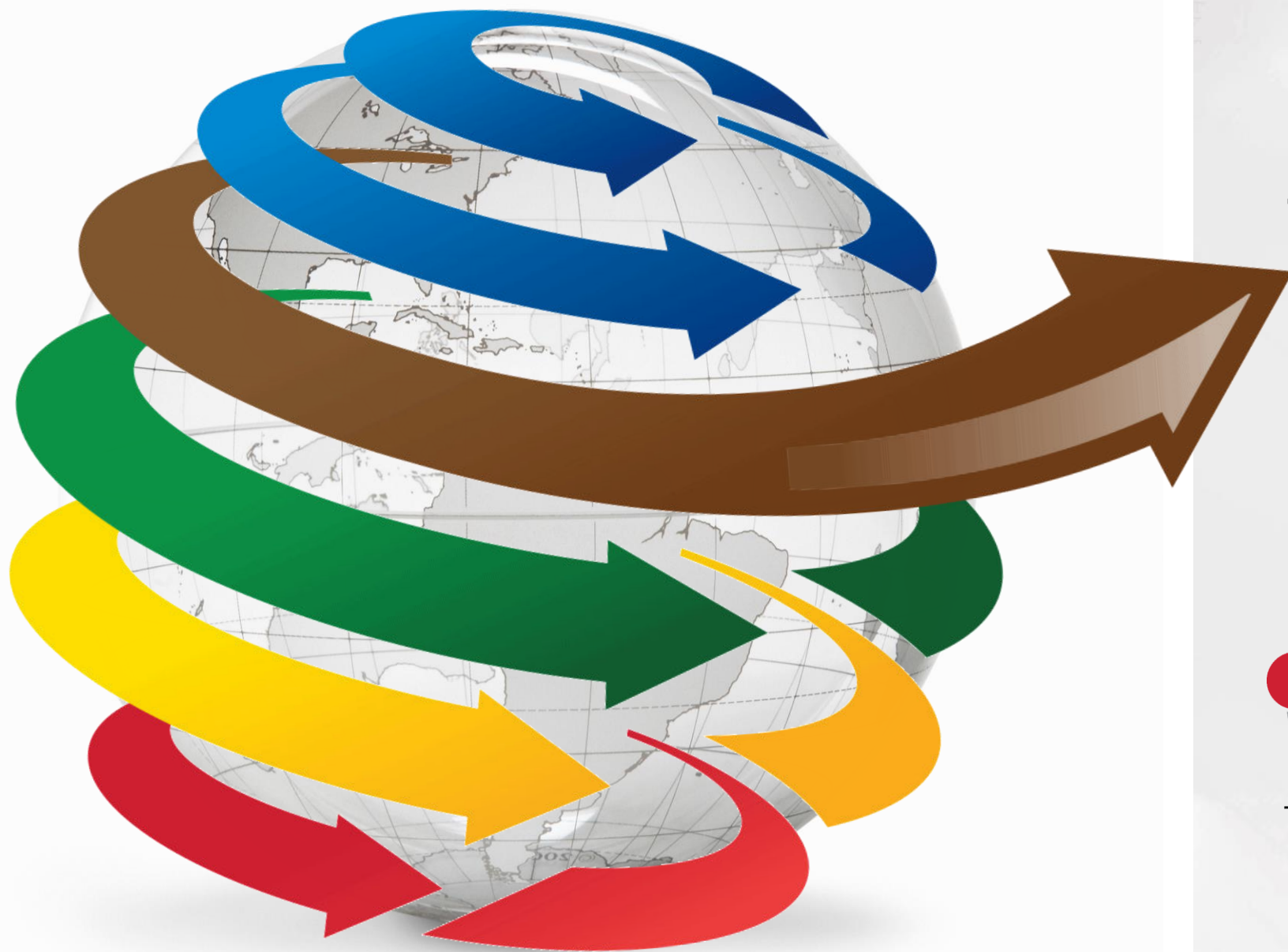
