²² then you shall inform your children ...



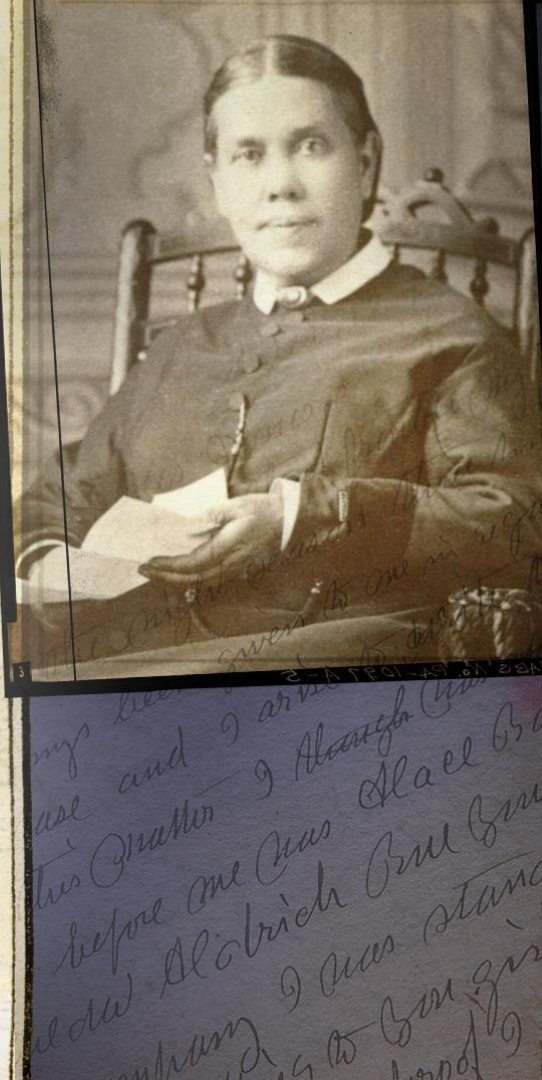
The 12 Stones of Remembrance in Joshua 4

past.***

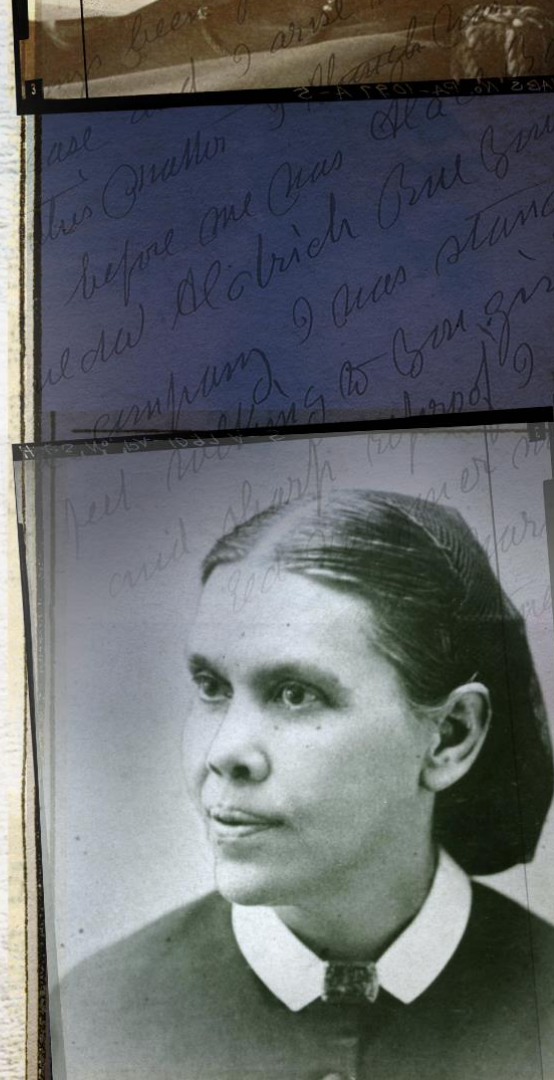

- *In all their original freshness and power these truths are to be given to the world.*

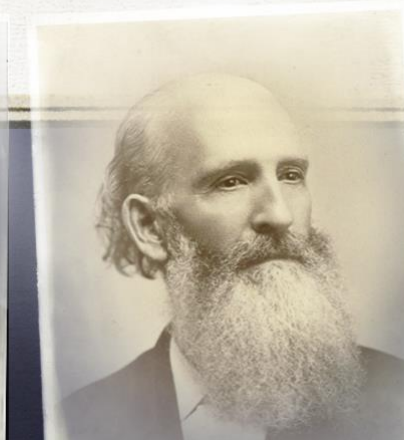
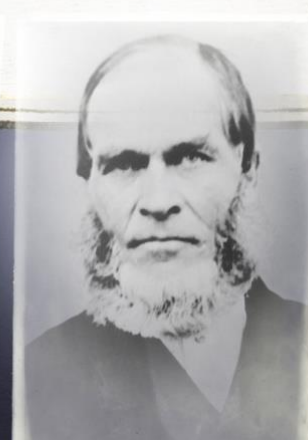
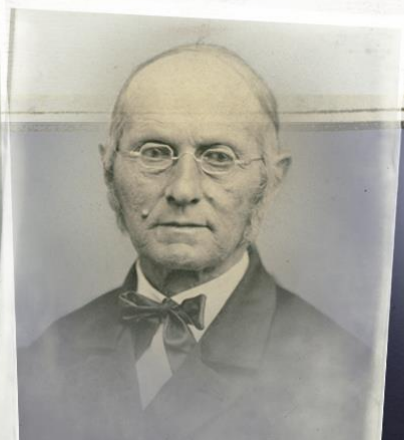
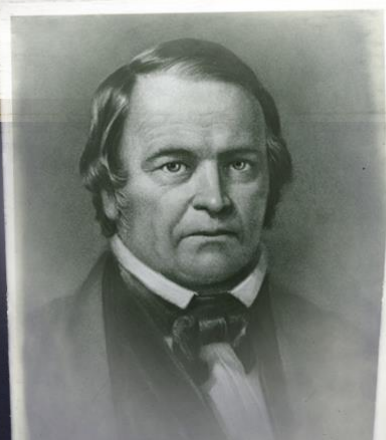
