John N. Andrews & family

In 1874 it was decided to send John N. Andrews “the ablest man in our ranks” (as Ellen White put it) to Europe as the church’s first missionary. Two years earlier, his wife, Angeline had died but John was determined to go and his two children were eager to go with him.

- (Charles lived to marry, and his son, also John N. Andrews, became the first missionary to Tibet)
