














A Universal problem..










Team users (Gethsemane)

Consent is an important and often overlooked part of how we store and manage sensitive information. Giving the power back to the contact themselves, in how their information will be used is desirable. Making this easy to update in a safe and secure way is key.



Thrive Glossary

Thrive User	A verified individual, a Seventh-day Adventist Member, who plays various roles and carries different responsibilities within Thrive.
Thrive Contact	A person about whom Thrive Users maintain information. These contacts are often Church Members or Students, but primarily include non-Adventist individuals whom Users are supporting and guiding on their faith journey.
Thrive Team	A group of Contacts & Users, typically forming a Church or School. Teams represent the primary organizational unit within Thrive.
Thrive Group	A subdivision within a Team, such as a Church or School. While there's only one Team per Church or School, each Team can have multiple Groups. Examples include Grow Groups, Youth Groups, or Sports Groups.
Thrive Events	Scheduled activities and gatherings. Events can be set as public (accessible to the Team) or private. They are used for recording attendance and integrating with your calendar.
Interactions	Logged activities with each Thrive Contact, including Visits, Bible Studies, Phone Calls, Emails, Literature distribution, Prayer requests and responses, and other custom interactions.
Key Decisions	Milestones and significant choices made by Contacts on their spiritual journey, recorded to track their progress.
Interests	Topics or subjects that Contacts are interested in exploring, particularly in study or discussion settings.
Private Notes	Secure, end-to-end encrypted notes, visible only to the author, ensuring privacy and confidentiality.
Assigning Contacts	Functionality to assign/delegate Contacts to specific Users for focused care and nurturing.
Family Relationships	Feature to map and display familial connections between Contacts.
Reports	Insights and analytics providing oversight of Contacts, including follow-up statistics, response times for new connections, and overall team engagement.
Notifications	Timely alerts and reminders to facilitate accountability and support for ongoing interactions and responsibilities.
